Joint Training Strategy

- Development of Joint Training Strategy underpinned by Training Needs Assessment
- Replication
 - A system that can be replicated, with modification, in other TFCA's
- A Feedback system
 - Training needs across the GLTFCA are rapidly brought to the attention of concerned bodies (e.g. training institutes) and can be addressed.
- Internal criteria
 - Training interventions to support implementation of GLTFCA objectives & programmes.
- National Criteria
 - Both qualification and practical based training.
- SADC & International Criteria
 - Taking into account SADC training needs and systems they have in place.
 - What is required for training to be delivered.



Joint Training Strategy

- Develop the initial training information system/model
 - Determine the process to be put in place for a functional and continual monitoring of training needs within the GLTFCA.
- Tested at three nodes:
 - Pafuri-Sengwe (Node 1)
 - GLC (Node 3)
 - K2C (Node 5)

Joint Training Strategy

- Collect required information using appropriate methods
 - Visits & questionnaires, management, staff & communities
 - Noting what is or is not working, problem areas and where are improvements required.
 - How can training be delivered.
- Analyze information
- Implement at Pafuri Area, K2C and GLC.
