




Institutional status and update

- Status/category: Treaty of 2015 in place.
- Management systems being developed/harmonized: eg.
 - M&E /Data Management systems – Under GIZ project,
 - Proposal for sustainable financing system to be prepared with support from GIZ
- Management documents:
 - Integrated Management Development Framework (IMDF) under preparation with support from GIZ/PPF
 - Not yet (for instance Disaster Risk Reduction Plan, Community Engagement plan, Capacity building plan)



Activities carried out in 2017-2018

- Preparation of GMPs/IMDF supported by GIZ/PPF
 - 1 Joint Park Management Committee Meeting conducted for Kasungu and Lukusuzi
 - 3 Cross border community meetings
 - 2 Joint boundary patrols & several cross border investigations
 - No cross border tourism products as of yet – rehabilitation of road/airstrip in Kasungu supported by IFAW.

Future plans

- ▶ Finalization of IMDF/joint of M&E system
- ▶ Preparation of proposal for sustainable financing
- ▶ Conduct more joint community engagement (include exchange visits for communities under GIZ project).
- ▶ Install radio communication with support from GIZ/IFAW which will facilitate more joint investigation & enforcement programmes



Constraints and added value

- Cross border movement of officers eg extensive distances to access immigration services.
- **Added value:**
 - Improved management capacity (staff & community trainings)
 - Strong collaboration (more stakeholders participating)
 - Increased awareness
