



ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTANCY SERVICES - CALL FOR PROPOSALS
SITUATIONAL ANALYSIS: LAND USE AND OWNERSHIP
MAPUTO PROVINCE - MOZAMBIQUE
(Contract Period: Three Months)



The National Conservation Agency (ANAC) is responsible for the management and development of all national protected areas in Mozambique. Peace Parks Foundation (PPF) is a non-profit company established to facilitate the establishment and development of Transfrontier Conservation Areas (TFCAs) in southern Africa. PPF is currently supporting the development of Lubombo Transfrontier Conservation Area (LTFCA) with the support of ANAC. The Parties require the services of an experienced Consultant to conduct a Situational Analysis to investigate and establish amongst others, land use and land ownership within the buffer zone of the Mozambique component of the LTFCA.

Reporting:

The Consultant will enter into a Service Level Agreement (SLA) with Peace Parks Foundation with the support of ANAC. As part of the initial project introduction and scoping phase, a joint planning and coordination meeting will be held with the Supervisory Team, ANAC, FNDS (National Sustainable Development Fund) and *Sustenta* (Integrated Sustainable Rural Development Project) regarding rural development and land rights.

Requirements:

- At least ten years' relevant experience in the environmental and/or conservation field with a very good knowledge and understanding of the study area preferred.
- Ability to plan and work to a clear budget and time line.
- A demonstrated ability to utilise technology including computer literacy skills.
- Strong communication skills.
- A working knowledge of English is considered essential while an ability to communicate in Portuguese/Shangaan/Zulu/Tsonga will be an advantage.
- Mozambique Citizenship or a legal working permit for the duration of the contract period shall be considered advantageous.

Methodology and Scope:

The implementation process, including data collection through a combined desktop- and literature study, site visits and stakeholder engagements, will be phased in line with deliverables as specified in the Terms of Reference. Phases/broad deliverables include: 1) Inception Report, 2) Draft Report, 3) Implementation and Data Collection, 4) Close-out Report. The geographic scope of the analysis should cover the extent of the districts of the Maputo Province that are adjacent to, fall within the buffer zone or form key linkages between protected areas and the core component of the LCG-UTF TFCA. Key villages, settlements and/or focus regions will be specified in discussions with the Supervising Team during the Initiation Phase. ***Detailed Terms of Reference for the formal application process and consultancy stipulations to be provided upon submission of initial response to this notice.**

Remuneration: A competitive salary package will be negotiated, based on qualifications and experience. Limited Project Operational funding is available for relevant Stakeholder Engagements subject to prior approval by the Supervisory Team.
